The first of many discussions for our staff regarding the placement of each of our students into classrooms will begin in mid-June. These collaborative conversations will continue until the end of June and resume during the first week in September. As we expect to receive many new student registrations over the summer, which impacts our overall plans, we will not be able to place students into their classes until Friday, September 8th at the earliest.
