Pink Shirt Day: Feb. 25



PINK SHIRT DAY

Pink Shirt Day is a global anti-bullying movement held annually on the last Wednesday of February in Canada. It originated in 2007 in Berwick, Nova Scotia, after two high school students, David Shepherd and Travis Price, witnessed a fellow student being bullied and threatened with homophobic insults for wearing a pink polo shirt. To show solidarity, they distributed 50 pink shirts to their peers, creating a "sea of pink" that effectively silenced the bullies.

While now a broad call to end all forms of bullying, Pink Shirt Day remains deeply connected to LGBTQ2S+ inclusion because of its origins in countering homophobia and transphobia.
