Bangla Heritage Week in British Columbia, proclaimed for April 12–18, 2026, celebrates the culture, history, and contributions of Bangla-speaking communities, coinciding with the Bangla New Year (Pohela Boishakh). It recognizes the community's role in BC's diverse society, highlighting traditions, language, and the vibrant culture of Bangladeshi, Indian, and other South Asian residents.



Vaisakhi (or Baisakhi) is a major Sikh festival, celebrated annually on April 13 or 14, marking the creation of the Khalsa Order in 1699 by Guru Gobind Singh, representing Sikh identity, equality, and service. It also historically functions as a Punjab spring harvest festival, marked by community parades (Nagar Kirtan), special prayers, and community meals (langar).



INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PINK
APRIL 14, 2026

The International Day of Pink is a worldwide anti-bullying, anti-homophobia, and anti-transphobia event held annually on the second Wednesday of April. Originating in Canada in 2007, it encourages people to wear pink to stand in solidarity with 2SLGBTQIA+ communities, promoting diverse and inclusive spaces in schools and workplaces.

Yom HaShoah (pronounced Yom ha-SHOW-ah) is Holocaust Remembrance Day. It is a special, solemn day to remember the six million Jewish people—including 1.5 million children—who were killed by the Nazis during World War II.

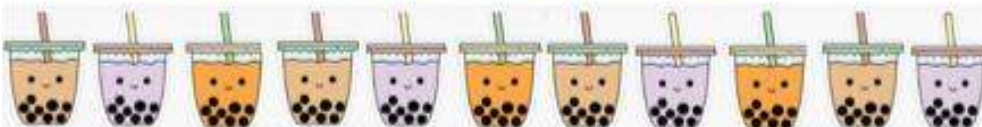
