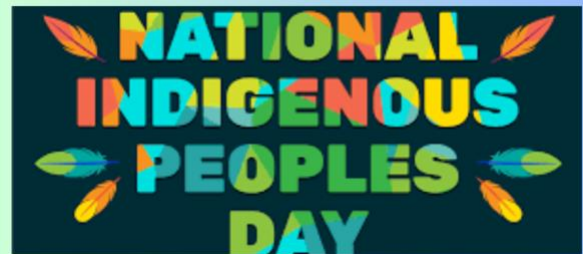
June is Filipino Heritage Month, Italian Heritage Month,
