At school, we support students in navigating conflicts in peaceful ways- sharing their feelings and working through disagreements without causing further harm to each other. We focus on restorative justice- acknowledging and taking responsibility for our actions, and repairing any harm that has occurred. As a parent, if your child shares a concern about another student, please bring it to school staff rather than addressing the other child directly. Adult-to-child confrontations can feel intimidating, escalate tensions between families, and often rely on incomplete information. Our staff are here to listen, investigate, and support all students while maintaining confidentiality and a safe, respectful school community. Thank you for helping model positive problem-solving for our children.

On Thursday we will have a "Spirit Day" at school... where students and staff might dress up for a theme for fun, if they choose. This month it is "Twin/Multiples Day"... students can dress up to "twin" with a friend, or dress alike with multiple friends! Or they can wear their McKay shirt and be a multiple with many staff and students that day!
